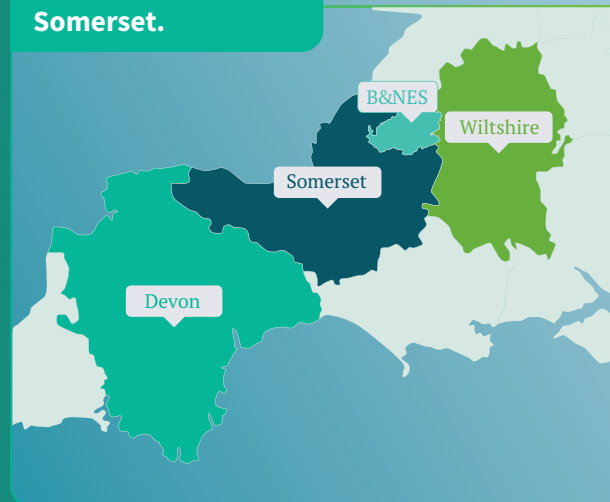
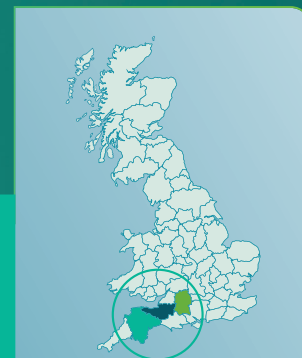

Let us help

We can assist you with a number of administrative support services if required, although we do not offer these ourselves.

These include; Age UK's Care Act Advocacy, arranging banking consultations, or assistance in arranging personal effects insurance. We would encourage you to take time to learn about the Residents & Relatives Association which offers information and advice for residents and their families. If you have already made arrangements to appoint an Enduring/Lasting Power of Attorney, or a Court Appointed Deputy, in the case of diminished mental capacity, please provide copies of the relevant documentation to the management of the home. Please speak to the Manager or ask for more information. Please note that members of staff are not permitted to assist you with the preparation of any legal documentation, including acting as a witness or executor.



Funding and support

We understand that friendships often develop between residents and the staff who care for them, however, please be mindful that our company policy prevents our employees from accepting gifts of a high value. Similarly, members of staff or their relatives are not permitted to benefit from the will of a resident. For more information, please speak to the Manager.

Although we recognise that it's a difficult topic for discussion, we invite you to speak to us about any wishes you have regarding the end of your life, including your thoughts on resuscitation, advance care planning and funeral arrangements.

Your privacy is of the utmost importance to us and steps have been taken in accordance with the Data Protection Act to guard your personal information.

You have the right to access any information held by Somerset Care which relates to you.



Wellbeing and activities

Everything that is important to you, is important to us.

The home's activities team put together a fun-packed programme of events, activities and entertainment each week, and you are free to join in with as much or as little as you choose.

Your loved ones are welcome to visit your home at any time, with your consent, and they are invited to join in the fun.

In addition to popular, regular activities like crafts and quizzes, musical entertainment and day trips out to explore the local area, awareness days are marked, special occasions are celebrated and all of our residents are invited to suggest things that are of particular interest to them.



Technology in our homes

Key to the wellbeing of our residents is the ability for them to live rich, fulfilling lives and remain in contact with their loved ones. Our care home is fully equipped with free Wifi throughout (including in bedrooms, communal areas and garden spaces) to help you stay connected and access on-demand entertainment such as catch-up TV should you choose. Somerset Care's central IT team can support you to set up and troubleshoot personal smart devices that you may choose to bring with you into the home, including mobile phones, tablets, smart speakers and smart TVs.

The home's care team can assist you with video calling, virtual attendance at family events and special occasions (e.g. weddings and celebrations) where attendance in person is not possible, and enable access to digital care plans.
